

## **Urgent Prayer Request from John and Jacky Taylor**

Greetings from Budapest, Hungary!

We would appreciate your prayers tomorrow.

Our family arrived to Budapest on Wednesday, hoping to get new visas to remain in Ukraine, since our old ones are about to expire. (Yes, it was time for our annual out-of-the-country visa trip.) Since the Ukrainian visa laws changed considerably (and unexpectedly) on September 10th, the officials are not clear themselves on how to proceed under the new system. Apparently, we are among the first in the country to apply for this new type of visa, and as a result the officials were unsure of what to do with us. They were unable to get us the necessary documents in time for our trip while they deliberated, and so we set out for the airport last week by faith.

Praise the Lord that friends in Odessa and in Kyiv were able to complete the process for us, and get the new documentation by courier to us in Budapest on Friday. We now go to the Ukrainian embassy tomorrow (Monday) morning. Pray that all would go without a hitch, and that we would be able to pick up our new visas by Wednesday, before we return to Ukraine.

In all of this, God has given us a calm. We know that he is in control, and will make it possible for us to stay in Ukraine for as long as He wills.
